It is because of their willingness to sacrifice for their beliefs in spite of the many pitfalls, tests and obstacles which they have faced.

At this final stage the remanent of Hopi traditionals have reached the turning point into the next phase of life. They foresee the possibility of getting help from superior Man has become hopeless.

Replaying the Ancient Drama

Since the time of Creation the Hopi have come a long way in world after world. The first world was peaceful and pure, in harmony with all living things in every way. These first people were given instructions or laws by the Great Creator to live by in peace so they could live perfect ways of life. He warned them not to be tempted into any wrong doings, that if they disobeyed His laws they would be punished. Even their land could be pulled away from under them.

After many years they increased to great numbers and became so strong and powerful that they lost sight of the Creator's instructions. They began to live by their

own designs, opposing the original laws, thinking they were above the laws of our Creator and Nature. They began to do things they were not supposed to do. This led to corruption of the leadership, power struggles, social immorality and hostility which led to the battle fields. As a whole all things were out of control. So, as they had been warned, the Creator had their land sink beneath the sea.

In world after world some form of natural catastrophe occurred because mankind failed to learn from their experiences. However, as each world reached the brink of being destroyed, there were always a small group of people surviving who, with strong devotion to the laws of the Great Creator, continued to maintain the balance of land and life during the new age.

We hope you will ponder the above story of our elders and reach some insight into the past adventures of mankind and understand the relationship to life today. The seeds of crisis man carries along as he travels from world to world. The repeat of the past which the world's people are now facing illustrates the ancient drama.

Let us take a look into the Hopi world. When Hopi came upon their new land it was in order and untarnished. They were happy and lived peacefully for many years. Then a foreign race arrived and by their influence they took control over the land and our lives. As it had been prophesied, they came with great ambition and generosity. They were clever and cunning. Trouble commenced, just as it had happened in our previous worlds. Unrest came because of corruption in high places and among the common people, with power struggles and arms races. The world situation today is getting out of control. We are confused, no knowing that we are, each of us, playing a certain part in the drama. A role cast either for a better life or for disaster.

Prophecy of the U.N. And Final Instruction

The prophecy regarding the House of Mica (U.N.) has been in our message a number of times. No doubt, by now you understand the significance the U.N. has for the Hopi. We respect it as a sacred organized establishment, given duties to perform in resolving the problems of this troubled world. Hopi were instructed to go there when the day came that they faced depressing problems which threatened to destroy their nation.

There would be extraordinary events caused by men with great ambition. They would begin to interfere with the land and the life of the people. They would explore the secrets of Nature and create a powerful weapon, the "gourd of ashes" belonging to Massau the Great Spirit, which will be very dangerous to the earth and all life. It can lead to total destruction.

When the gourd of ashes (A-bomb) was dropped on Japan the Hopi saw it as a clear sign to go to the U.N. with their message. To remind them not to make further experiments with destructive weapons. The Hopi were instructed to go there four times. So during four decades Hopi walked to the door of the United Nations. Each time finding the door closed until on the fourth attempt the door was open. But not to the hall of world leaders where we were supposed to deliver our message before them on the two

subjects above.

We were able to file our complaint against our oppressors in the U.S. Government for wrongs done, with the help of the Human Rights Organization through Geneva. There was no positive response from the world leaders to assist us so that our village could continue to be independent.

We learned from our experiences in the Geneva hearings that we didn't seem to understand one another. We don't understand their systems or procedures in following their own rules. Neither did they understand our system, the rules which lie within our spiritual knowledge and wisdom, the Divine Laws.

After reviewing the prophecy and instructions, we see the outlook for getting aid from the United Nations becomes dim maybe even fruitless. We realized its functioning is under the control of the U.S. Government. That our case would linger on with little hope of success. That it would be impossible for us to invest more time and expense in it.

Other aspects we see which we have learned from the past. There are always periodic changes when land and life are off balance. Today we, mankind, are well advanced beyond the doctrine of morality, that by our conduct and behavior we cause unbalance. Our Mother Earth is aged and ill. She may no longer nourish life in the near future because of the abuses by mankind. On this basis Hopi leaders proclaim their determination to continue to follow in the footsteps of Massau, the Great Spirit, on the path he instructed us to follow because mankind of today fails to heed the warnings by natural causes to correct his way of life.

Now Hopi, in accord with the prophetic instructions, throw their case behind them as we go into the next phase, the final instruction. Hopi have now fulfilled the prophecy regarding the U.N.

The question will be: "Why did Hopi discard their case? Is it because it became useless?" Indeed it is not so. Hopi have been hopeful that it would come into the hands of those who will have the duty to fulfill the Great Purification Day that Hopi await. Let us quote some words of Chief Katchongva, one of the strong and wise devoted leaders in our village of Hotevilla...

"We will have three people standing behind us, ready to fulfill our prophecy, when we get into hopeless difficulties. The symbols will be: Meha (shaped like the swastika), Sun symbol and Red symbol. Other color symbols may be involved. One of them will be our long lost White brother bringing his stone tablet which will match the Hopi tablet when laid side by side. The three will unite and come to purify Hopi and all people. They will weed out the wicked who disturbed our ways of life. The wicked will be beheaded and will speak no more. This will be a purification for all righteous people. The ills of the earth will be cured. Mother Earth will bloom again and all people will unite in peace and harmony for a long time to come." So Chief Katchongva has spoken.

The Hopi elders say we are now living on the fourth world, the last one. So it will be impossible to escape to any peaceful world as we did in ancient times. The only hope for the world's people is purification. Otherwise if man has no intention of cleansing his heart of evil and greed work for world peace will be in vain. Hope of survival will also be in vain. The choice is ours, the last age for mankind and Earth will in the end be up to our Creator and Nature in making the decision.

There is a little hope left which is very simple: that the Hopi and all indigenous people be recognized by the Bahanna government, other governments and by the world's people. The destructive Western influence must cease so that the minority of Hopi now left can rebuild their old traditions and culture. This will prevent the Hopi identity from vanishing. Otherwise there may be no hope for survival if the Creator decides to pull away our land from under us.

Do not be alarmed, this may not happen tomorrow or even in your lifetime. It could be in your children's or their children's lifetime, as old Hopi would say. This may be the greatest challenge faced by man. Not many will agree or disagree, but once peace or annihilation has been established, on one of these bases we will rejoice or suffer the consequences. It may not be too late for us to correct ourselves so don't lose hope.
